In the Library:

Write down the reader's interest category (represented by an easily recognizable pictogram), then the mark, which is the "address" of the item within the reader's interest category.

Example:

L'herbier oublié: secrets de plantes retrouvés

Reader's interest category «Univers, nature» → 

Mark: U-581.9

PEJOU:

The PEJOU system (in French) suggests the age range to which the book corresponds.

The mark always includes this prefix to help you:

- P – Petite enfance = Babies and toddlers
- E – Enfants = Emergent and early readers - children
- J – Jeunes = Fluent readers - children
- O – adOs = Teens
- U – adUlteS = Adults

Example: P-STEIN ou O-ROWL

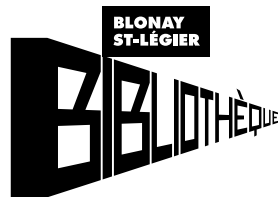
ONLINE ACCESS POLICY
